2 Year Olds

During Autumn we have explored a range of sensory activities to build on the children's motor skills and extend their vocabulary.



We have introduced a nursery rhyme a week which we sing and sign at different times throughout each session, the children are being to use repeated Makaton signs independently in their play. Our favourite this term was

Miss Polly had a Dolly. The children have dressed up as Doctors and Nurses while developing their mark making skills writing prescriptions and

letters to Miss Polly. Our sensory activities and role play provide opportunities for the adults to build and extend vocabulary.





We have been learning about ourselves, our families and our emotions, plus settling into school and learning to make new friends. We've also been learning about he story of Diwali, how it is celebrated and how this festival is similar to some of our own eg Bonfire Night and Christmas. We tasted some food and made some coconut Diwali sweets.

We took part in Nursery Rhyme of the Week and loved reciting them.

We read Room on the Broom which we linked in with Halloween. We are getting to know the story really well. We made exploding potions, explored rhyming spells and immersed ourselves in the witches kitchen.

We also read another Julia Donaldson book -Superworm, which is linked to our Autumn Trip and the Superworm Trial at Delamere Forest. We have also been learning more about worms through digging for them, making a wormery and making edible worms and soil.




