We are delighted to welcome back all the children who have returned to us and are pleased at how well the new children are settling in to 'life at nursery'. We are now well into our 30 hour offer and children are enjoying a healthy packed lunch. If your child started in Sept I've attached a questionnaire for you to fill in. If your child is returning there are some questions we would like you to ask your child, to help gain their view of nursery school. I would also like to take this opportunity to remind you about a few points and to give you advance warning of some things which will be happening throughout the year.

Water bottles- You can bring in a named bottle with water in (not juice or flavoured water) for them to drink whenever they choose during the session. These must be taken home after the session to be refilled ready for the next day. Please be aware that staff will empty out anything which isn't water, as water is the healthiest option for your child, and anything else might pose a risk to another child with allergies.

Please bring in an A4 file so that we can start to record your child's time at nursery.

Snack money for this half term is £8 for 15 Hour children and £16 for 30



Can children please come in velcro shoes (NOT laces or difficult to put on trainers). We aim to encourage all children to be independent and shoes they can put on by themselves will help with this.

Stay and Play
