We are delighted to welcome back all the children who have returned to us and are pleased at how well the new children are settling in to 'life at nursery'. If your child started in Sept I've attached a questionnaire for you to fill in. If your child is returning there are some questions we would like you to ask your child, to help gain their view of nursery school. I would also like to take this opportunity to remind you about a few points and to give you advance warning of some things which will be happening throughout the year.

Water bottles- You can bring in a named bottle with water in <u>(not juice or flavoured water)</u> for them to drink whenever they choose during the session. These must be taken home after the session to be refilled ready for the next day. Please be aware that staff will empty out anything which isn't water, as water is the healthiest option for your child, and anything else might pose a risk to another child with allergies.





#### 30 Hour children – Packed Lunches

Could you please make sure that your child's name is on all of their bags, boxes and bottles? Please don't give your child too much- a sandwich, fruit and yoghurt plus a drink is fine. Any grapes must be cut in half length ways so they are not a choking hazard. Thank you.

**Attendance** - We are already assessing all children and planning to support their next steps. It is really important for children to come every day to ensure that they are not missing any of the exciting things we have planned. If your child is not well please phone to let us know.

Reading to your child is really important in teaching them about books and pre reading skills. The home school library is open every day and your child can visit and choose a book to take home and share with you. Book bags are on sale at £4.00 each. If you have any adult books please send them in, we want to encourage children to read and seeing you read is a good way!
