We are delighted to welcome back all the children who have returned to us and are pleased at how well the new children are settling in to 'life at nursery'. If your child started in September I've attached a questionnaire for you to fill in. If your child is returning there are some questions we would like you to ask your child to help gain their view of nursery school.

you advance warning of some things which will be happening throughout the year.

30 Hour Children – Could you please make sure your child's name is on all their lunch bags & bottles. Please don't give your child too much – a sandwich, fruit & yoghurt plus a drink is fine. **GRAPES** must be cut in half lengthways so they are not a choking hazard, your child should always have a drink too please.

Home/School Library Reading to your child is really important in teaching them about books and developing pre reading skills. We are starting to offer our home school book scheme again. As you are not

coming in to the setting at the moment we will support children to choose a book at the end of their session and bring it home to share with you. We ask that children have a bag to protect the book as it moves between home and school. Children can choose a book to share at home. Book bags are on sale £4.00. We would like to display photos of your child and their families reading books so please send in any photos you may have for us to display.





Water bottles- You can bring in a named bottle with <u>water</u> only (not juice or flavoured water) into the classroom for your child to have a drink whenever they choose during the session. These must be taken home after the session to be refilled ready for the next day. Please be aware that staff will empty out anything other than water. Water is the healthiest option for your child & their teeth. Other drinks may pose a risk to another child with allergies.

Attendance We are already assessing all children and planning to support their next steps. It is really important for children to come every day to ensure that they are not missing any of the exciting things we have planned. If your child is not well please phone to let us know.





Could all children please have an appropriate coat and wellies (all named) at nursery – we try to go outside everyday!



Can children please come in velcro shoes (NOT laces or difficult to put on trainers). We aim to encourage all children to be independent and shoes they can put on by themselves will help with this.

Snack money for this half term is £8.00 15 hour £16.00 30 hour. Can we remind parents that snack is in addition to your child's nursery funding so can you please also pay snack for this current half term if you haven't already done so.

Stay and play We have been thinking about how we can offer this so that you can come into the setting and spend time with your child, speak to you child's key person and teacher, and still ensure that everyone feels as safe as possible. Whilst infection rates in Halton are still quite high, and young children are often asymptomatic, we have decided to offer this as an outside session for an hour at the start of your child's session time. We will use the classroom, the outside covered play space (if wet), and the outdoor area if possible to ensure that everyone can socially distance and ventilation is maximised. There will be time to play with your child and to discuss their progress with their key person and your child's teacher. Amanda/Lynn will also be there to talk to you. Nearer to the time we will be asking about your intention to attend so that we can complete our risk assessment.
