Attendance

Imagine That! Following our lovely trip to Delamere Forest we have now planned our next trip to Imagine That! This will be held Monday 4th March. We have booked the whole venue so we can explore the environment and learn about some exciting science experiments.



Dummies

We are really pleased to see that the number of Dummies coming into Nursery School has dropped. There is now lots of evidence to show that they delay children's speech development and if used too often they change the shape of the teeth as they are forming. Please come and see is if you need any advice / help with this.

MOMO Challenge - It has been brought to our attention that an alleged form of Cyberbullying is being spread through social media, eg through Kids You Tube, What's App etc. This is something called the "Momo Challenge" where apparently an animated face instructs children to take part in challenges, for example "touching the cooker". Please be vigilant when your child is using the internet, making sure that you are near them and can hear what they are playing. Information on helping you to keep your children safe on line was given out at last terms. Stay and Play session, but if you need any further guidance please come and speak to us.

30 Hour children - Packed Lunches

Please make sure your child has a sandwich, fruit, treat (biscuits / crisp) and a drink. Anything more often over faces them. Also could you make sure that grapes are cut in half length ways so they are not a choking hazard. Lunch time is a really social occasion and we encourage the children to sit and wait for their friends to finish before going outside or to play.

Please remember that children should only bring water in their drinking bottles and **NOT** juice. All children are provided with milk or water at snack time and have access to drinking water throughout the day.

Please remember to pay your half termly contribution of £8 for 15 Hour children and £16 for 30 hour children. This cannot come out of our budget so in order to provide snack we rely on your contribution. This can now be paid by bank transfer, please see reception if you would like details.
