If your child is in green group there will also be chance for you to talk to the staff about how they have settled.

The focus for this stay and play will be nursery rhymes (green group) and developing writing skills (blue and red group). There will be time to play with your child and chance for a drink and a chat with myself or Suzanne about how the children learn how to write and how you can support them at home.

30 Hour children - Packed Lunches

Please make sure your child has a sandwich, fruit, treat (biscuits / crisp) and a drink. Anything more often over faces them. Lunch time is a really social occasion and we encourage the children to sit and wait for their friends to finish before going outside or to play.

Contact Numbers

Water bottles

Please remember that children should only bring water in their drinking bottles and NOT juice. All children are provided with milk or water at snack time and have access to drinking water throughout the day.

Snack Money

Please remember to pay your half termly contribution of £8 for 15 Hour children and £16 for 30 hour children. This cannot come out of our budget so in order to provide snack we rely on your contribution. This can now be paid by bank transfer, please see reception if you would like details.



World Book Day - 1st March

Children can come dressed as a character from a book if they wish. Each child will receive a voucher for a free book, or against another book of their choice.



Post Box We have a post box situated at the nursery door.

Parents can post snack money,

trip money and any other replies or information. Please ensure all payments are in an envelope with your child's name clearly labelled and information of what the contents are.

We welcome donations of any children's clothes that you no longer need. Children at times have accidents or get wet and messy and it is useful for us to have a supply of clothes to change children into at nursery.
