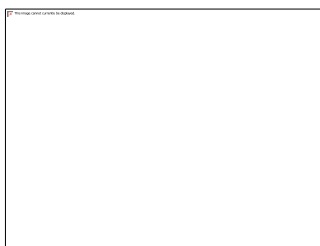
Post Box We have a post box situated at the nursery door.

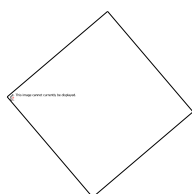
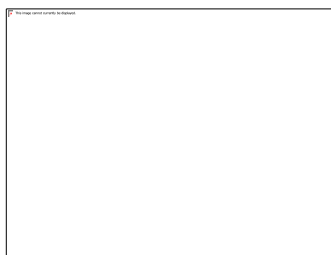
New Schools
