Sports Relief Day


Children will take part in sport activities. Friday 18th March donation's welcome. Children are welcome to dress in sports gear or fancy dress, ready to run!

Communication Station



Disabled Car Park Spaces

Please do not park in these spaces unless you are registered disabled and are displaying your blue badge. Staff will challenge anyone who is parking here unless they can see this displayed and you will be asked to move.

Water bottles- You can bring in a named bottle with water in (not juice or flavoured water) and put it in the box above your child's peg for them to have a drink whenever they choose during the session. These must be taken home after the session to be refilled ready for the next day. Please be aware that staff will empty out anything which isn't water, as water is the healthiest option for your child, and anything else might pose a risk to another child with allergies.
