Supporting your child at home

Each half term we email out a sheet of things you can play with/do at home with your child. They are really easy practical things based on your child's current interest. They all have a link to a story to share with your child. Evidence shows that when parents/carers support their children in learning at home their success at school is greater. This can be sharing books at bedtime, playing simple board games, I spy, lego etc. Have a look at the ideas we send out to you & have a go!



Stay and Play

These sessions are an opportunity for you to Stay and Play with your child during the session at nursery - to look at the sorts of things they do, to see how we speak to children, and how we engage them in learning. We will run the sessions outside again this term so please come dressed for the weather! There will be a chance to chat to your child's key person, their qualified teacher & senior staff plus a chance to play with your child at nursery school. We also use this time to talk about ways you can support your child at home. We have set dates for the year as follows:

Could you please ensure your child's name is on all their lunch bags & bottles. Please don't give your child too much – a sandwich, fruit & yoghurt plus a drink is fine. Also could you make sure that GRAPES are cut in half lengthways so are not a choking hazard and could children always have a drink too please.

Snack money for this half term is £8.00. Can we remind parents that snack is in addition to your child's nursery funding so can you please also pay snack for this current half term if you haven't already done so.

Could all children please have an appropriate coat and wellies (all named) at nursery – we try to go outside everyday!



Water bottles- You can bring in a named bottle with water in (not juice or flavoured water) and put it in the box above your child's peg for them to have a drink whenever they choose during the session. These must be taken home after the session to be refilled ready for the next day. Please be aware that staff will empty out anything which isn't water, as water is the healthiest option for your child, and anything else might pose a risk to another child with allergies.

Please drive carefully outside the children's centre.

Please also remember to use the car park and not park on the yellow zig – zags
