Please ensure your child has appropriate sun lotion and this is applied before they come to nursery school. A hat during the hot weather is essential along with clothes that cover the skin to prevent sunburn. The children can also bring a bottle with water into keep in the box above their peg. Please remember that children are only able to have water in their bottles and not juice. We operate a healthy eating policy and also some children have allergies to the colouring and flavourings in juice.

We understand that primary schools are still a little different but when possible can you start to move towards our session times to avoid interruption for the children.

Operation Encompass

All schools in Halton, Warrington, Cheshire West & Chester and Cheshire East participate in a project called Operation Encompass. This is run in partnership with Cheshire Police and aims to support children aged 4 and over who are affected by domestic abuse.

Following a domestic abuse incident, the Police will make contact with the school and communicate relevant information to nominated school staff, to ensure that the school are made aware early enough to support children and young people in a way that means they feel safe and included.

Each school has a member of staff (key adult) who is trained to liaise with the police, when required, whilst ensuring support is available to the child.

We are committed to working in partnership, to safeguard and protect children across Cheshire and provide the best possible care and support for our pupils.

Water is the healthiest option for your child & their teeth. Other drinks may pose a risk to another child with allergies.
